

Together For Worship - Mark 16:1-7 & I Corinthians 15:50-58

A guide to worship as a family in your home

Set aside a time when everyone in your family is ready for a time of worship together in your home. Also, make sure to read through the text first before you begin.

Pray Together-

- ⊕ Spend time together praying for the Holy Spirit to move in your time of worship.

Sing Together-

- ⊕ Sing any or all of the songs below which are the songs for corporate worship (they are available on You Tube)
 - ✓ Oh Praise The Name, Amazing Grace, Christ The Lord Is Risen Today

Catch the Idea Together

- ⊕ As a family, make resurrection rolls. Find the recipe by searching “Resurrection Rolls- Allrecipes.com” Talk about the truth of the resurrection.
- ⊕ In the passage that we are reading today, we see the truth of Jesus’ death and resurrection. We know that Jesus died on the cross to be our substitute and die the death that we all deserved. Romans 5:8 tells us that “God demonstrated His love for us in this, that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.” We see the beauty of the victory on the cross. But, we know that the story does not end there. We know that Jesus rose from the grave to conquer death forever. Today, we read about the joy of what happened that Sunday morning and the joy and hope we have as believers as we live as sojourners in this world.

Discuss His Word Together-

- ⊕ Open up God’s Word and read Mark 16:1-8
 - ✓ What happened on Good Friday? (look at verse 6a)
 - ✓ What happened three days later that Sunday morning? (look at verse 6b)
- ⊕ Read I Corinthians 15:3-9, 25-26, and 50-58
 - ✓ Who does Jesus appear to after He has risen from the grave (verses 3-9)? What does this show us about the truth of the resurrection?
 - ✓ What is the hope we read about in verses 50-54?
 - ✓ In Verse 26, and 54-55 what has happened to death?
 - ✓ In Verse 56 and 57, what is the victory we have in Christ?

Applying What We Are Learning Together

- ⊕ Discuss the victory we have in Christ is because of His death and resurrection.
- ⊕ As we await Jesus’ return, what is our hope in light of Jesus’ death and resurrection?
- ⊕ Read Philippians 3:20-21. How should we await Jesus’ return?

Closing Prayer Together

⊕ Closing Prayer Points

- ✓ Praise God for providing the payment for our sins.
- ✓ Praise God for Jesus rising from the grave and being victorious over death.
- ✓ Praise God that He provided salvation.
- ✓ Pray for those in your community that need to hear the good news of the gospel.
- ✓ Pray that we would eagerly await Jesus' return by living for Him and proclaiming the gospel.

⊕ As you pray, an idea is the A.C.T.S prayer acronym.

- ✓ Adoration- How can we adore God in our prayer time (God you are powerful, faithful...)
- ✓ Confession- Take time to confess your sins to God (Remember 1 John 1:9)
- ✓ Thanksgiving - What can we praise God for this week?
- ✓ Supplication - Talk with God about things on your heart.
