

# Together For Worship - Mark 9:30-37, 10:32-45

## A guide to worship as a family in your home

Set aside a time when everyone in your family is ready for a time of worship together in your home. Also, make sure to read through the text first before you begin.

### Pray Together-

- ⊕ Spend time together praying for the Holy Spirit to move in your time of worship.

### Sing Together-

- ⊕ Sing any or all of the songs below which are the songs for corporate worship (they are available on You Tube)
  - ✓ All I Have Is Christ, Resurrection Power, Cornerstone, Lay Me Down,

### Catch the Idea Together

- ⊕ Ask everyone in your family right now to do something to serve one another.
- ⊕ In our passage today, we will again, like last week, look at what is called “The Great Discipleship Discourse.” Jesus tells the disciples that He will suffer, be rejected, die and will rise again. Immediately following Jesus’ words, the disciples respond in a way that shows they do not fully grasp the meaning of what Jesus is saying. Jesus responds and teaches them about what it means to truly follow Him as a disciple. Last week we saw that Jesus taught that His disciples must count the cost of following Him and share in His suffering. In these two responses to the disciples, Jesus shows them what it means for a disciple to be truly great.

### Discuss His Word Together-

- ⊕ Open up God’s Word and read Mark 9:30-32 and Mark 10:32-34
  - ✓ What did Jesus say would happen to Him?
- ⊕ Now read Mark 9:33-37 and Mark 10:35-45
  - ✓ How did the disciples respond each time to what Jesus said?
  - ✓ Why do you think they responded this way?
  - ✓ What did Jesus say to them about who is the greatest in each situation?

### Applying What We Are Learning Together

- ⊕ Take time to think through how to apply what we are learning
  - ✓ What does the world say you must be/do to be great? What does Jesus say you must be/do to be great?
  - ✓ How are you being great for the Kingdom? Are you humbly serving others?
  - ✓ What must we do to keep this attitude of greatness on our minds every day?
- ⊕ Discuss one way we can truly be great in serving others through being a disciple maker.
  - ✓ What does it mean to be a disciple maker? How is a disciple maker serving others? Who are you discipling? (Parents, talk to your kids about how they can look forward one day to discipling others as they grow in their walk with the Lord through discipleship.)

## Closing Prayer Together

### ⊕ Closing Prayer Points

- ✓ Pray Philippians 2:3-5
- ✓ Pray that God would help us be great by being a humble servant for the Kingdom.
- ✓ Pray that you would serve a believer by helping to disciple them.
- ✓ Pray that you would grow as a believer through a discipling relationship

### ⊕ As you pray, an idea is the A.C.T.S prayer acronym.

- ✓ Adoration- How can we adore God in our prayer time (God you are powerful, faithful...)
- ✓ Confession- Take time to confess your sins to God (Remember 1 John 1:9)
- ✓ Thanksgiving - What can we praise God for this week?
- ✓ Supplication - Talk with God about things on your heart.
