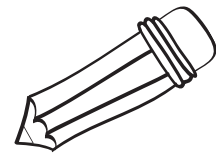

# Family Worship Guide- March 1-7

This Weeks Memory Verse: John 14:13

"Whatever you ask in My name, this I will do, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son."

## MONDAY

- Read John 14:7-14 and talk through the following discussion questions:
  - Read verses 10-12. Discuss what Jesus means when He says we will do greater works. How did Jesus make this possible? What are the kingdom sized works God calls us to?
  - What does it make you think about when you realize that God gives you the ability to accomplish kingdom sized works? (remember this doesn't mean you have to be Billy Graham or Lottie Moon)
  - Read verses 13-14. How can we accomplish kingdom sized works? What does it mean to pray in Jesus name?
  - Are you praying about how God wants to use you to accomplish kingdom sized works of evangelism, discipleship and serving - in your home, neighborhood, city & the nations? Are you praying this for Crosspoint?
- Pray for Crosspoint family: Idea- Write down names of Crosspoint families on slips of paper & put them into a bucket. Pull out a name & pray for that family/person.
- Pray for Crosspoint ministries.
  - Pray for our 2021 Stewardship Challenge: This week pray for the stewardship of our Crosspoint building and for our Next Steps Offering.
  - Pray for Bible Study Groups: If you did not have a chance to join the Bible Study groups...just join us this Sunday at 10am.
  - Pray that God would stir a boldness in our hearts, that we would remember who we are in Christ. Pray that a watching world would see unity in the church, when all that seems to be on display in our government right now is disunity.
- Pray through: Psalm 1, 31, 61, 91, or 121

## TUESDAY

- Choose one of these Psalms to read and pray through: Psalm 2, 32, 62, 92, or 122
- Pray for SEND Network Indiana
  - Pray as church planters are working through COVID-19 and gov't regulations.
  - Pray for Ernesto Fernandez and his wife Victoria. They are planting Primira Iglesia Bautista de Clarksville in Clarksville Indiana.
  - Pray that the church would be encouraged and that they would find ways to continue to stay connected. That they would find ways to continue to engage, live out, and share the gospel.

## WEDNESDAY

- Choose a Psalm to read and pray through: Psalm 3, 33, 63, 93, 123
- Pray for the local, state, and national government.
- Pray for our city:
  - Pray for Brianna's Hope. This ministry meets at the Methodist church on S16th and main. The purpose or goal of this ministry is to support and encourage people to overcome drug addiction. While we may not see drug addiction like bigger cities it is certainly a problem here in Richmond as well.

## THURSDAY

- Choose a Psalm to read and pray through: Psalm 4, 34, 64, 94, 124
- Pray for missions in Sub-Saharan Africa.
  - Pray that people in that region would be able to receive the Bible in their heart language.
  - Pray for missionaries in this regions as they use drama, art and song to teach the gospel right now because these people groups don't have the translation of the Bible in their language yet.
- Pray for your Who's your one?

## FRIDAY

- Choose a Psalm to read and pray through: Psalm 5, 35, 65, 95, 125
- Pray a prayer of adoration and thanksgiving.
- Pray for Crosspoint family: Idea- Write down names of Crosspoint families on slips of paper & put them into a bucket. Pull out a name & pray for that family/person.

## SATURDAY

- Read John 14:15-31, 15:26-27, 16:5-15 in preparation for Sundays sermon.
- Pray for Sunday worship
  - Pray as God readies our hearts to gather and worship together.
  - Pray for Pastor Dan as he finishes preparing for the sermon
  - Pray for your Who's your one? person
- Pray through Psalm 6, 36, 66, 96, 126

## SUNDAY

- Review and discuss what the Lord showed you through the sermon. What is one thing that you are going to apply?
- Pray through Psalm 7, 37, 67, 97, or 127
