

Dear Crosspoint family,

We have been so blessed as a church to see the goodness of God during this difficult year. We have had to lean on, and trust, the Lord to get us through everything, and He has been faithful.

Your elder team wants to say thank you for how you have followed our mask policy that began last July. We have worked in unity to make sure we can do everything possible to continue to meet for worship and events. We trust we can continue to do this together as we move forward.

Knowing it is our duty as your pastors to shepherd you as we move forward and to do everything we can to keep you safe as we gather together, your Elder team spent time in prayer and discussion during our regular scheduled Elder team meeting on April 14.

Therefore, as we continue to navigate, and fight, this pandemic together, your elder team has decided to update our mask policy. We believe these are good steps that we can take to encourage one another as we gather together. Therefore, here is what we ask:

1. As you enter the building and move throughout the building...
  - a. ...**if** you can maintain six feet social distance, we will not ask you to wear a mask.
  - b. ...**if** you cannot maintain that six feet social distance, we ask that you wear a mask. Because of this, we ask that you always have a mask with you.
  - c. ...**if** you feel more comfortable wearing a mask the entire time, please feel free to do that.
2. When you sit in the sanctuary please sit as a family unit. We will keep the chairs spaced 6ft apart.
3. If you volunteer in one of the following ministries you will need to wear a mask while volunteering in that ministry: kid's ministry, preschool praise, VBS, youth ministry, greeter ministry, sound room, and preparing of food/serving of food at events.
4. If you are feeling sick or were around someone who has had tested positive for Covid-19, please stay home and utilize the livestream from your home.

As we move forward, we want to continue to fight this pandemic together. Please keep in mind the concerns of others as we gather together. We also ask that you continue to pray about how we are to be a church that loves God, loves one another, and loves our community as we move forward. We know God will continue to work in us and through us as we work together.

Finally, please know that because this is a fluid situation, we will notify you immediately if things are changed or updated to this policy. Thank you Crosspoint family for your prayers and support during this challenging season. We appreciate each one of you.
