As we continue, remember these questions when you look at God's Word. Who is God? Who am I? How do I live that out daily in such a way that God is glorified?

I also want to continue to encourage you to have Faith talks with your family. Whether that is family altogether, some of your family, or just one other member of your family. What I mean by faith talks is in an unplanned moment, a normal life situation, connect that moment/situation to God's glory or God's story. This is not a big sermon/teaching/preaching time...it is simply a short moment of pointing out God's glory or story. Like when watching a movie, tv show, reading a book, seeing people at the story and how they are acting. Take those moments and share God's glory or story in those moments. Something to think about after your next movie or TV show that you watch...Where did this movie tell the truth about what is right and good? Where did this movie tell lies about right and good? What actions in this story should we try to copy? Which ones should we avoid? In what ways did the person who made this movie perhaps without even knowing it, include Reflections of God's story line (Creation, Redemption, Fall, New Creation)? MONDAY- Read and talk about Proverbs 23. **Watch the devotional video Pastor Josh posted to Crosspoint Facebook page.**

- Pray for the Elder team as they are seeking wisdom to lead and shepherd during this time of unfamiliarity.

TUESDAY- Read and talk about Proverbs 24.

- Praying for Richmond/Indiana/Nation - Pray that COVID-19(Coronavirus) would be taken serious by those that are trying to make it not that big of a deal. Not that people would be fearful of it, but that they would have love for neighbor and the desire to not help it spread. Pray that the diligence of people staying home will slow the spread as vaccines are being developed.

WEDNESDAY- Read and talk about Proverbs 25. **Watch the devotional video from Pastor Chad on Crosspoint Facebook page.**

- Pray for those that are in healthcare, that they would take the proper precautions for themselves and for the protection of their families and neighbors.

THURSDAY- Read and talk about Proverbs 26

- Praying for Churches/Ministry Partners - Pray for Jonathan and Yesenia Santiago. Jonathan serves as the director of Send Relief Puerto Rico. He works with local churches and agencies to identify people and communities in crisis and match the needs with the volunteer relief teams arriving each week. Jonathan says that physical needs are easier to address, but it's the emotional and spiritual issues that also must be acknowledged.

FRIDAY- Read and talk about Proverbs 27. **Watch devotional video Pastor Dan posted to Crosspoint Facebook page.**

- Praying for Family Missions Spotlight - Pray for Pastor Mike Palmer & Lemhi River Cowboy Church in Idaho.

SATURDAY- Read and talk about Proverbs 28

- Pray for Crosspoint that we would be ready to hear God's Word and be challenged and changed by it. Pray that the guests who visit Crosspoint, hear and sense the calling of the Holy Spirit in their lives. Pray that the guests are welcomed.

SUNDAY- Read and talk through Proverbs 29

- Pray for the churches around the world who have canceled services (in some cases without livestream or recording options). Pray that the pastors are able to have wisdom and that they would be encouraged during this uncertain timeframe.
